

ExitDoorShield

ExitDoorShield is an effective alarm which alerts staff to any unauthorised exits/entries through emergency exit doors and rear doors.

To safeguard emergency routes and panic locks, the ExitDoorShield is a highly visible deterrent which can be mounted underneath door handles, latches and panic bars. The device has been approved for use according to EN179 and EN1125.

ExitDoorShield discourages the misuse of door handles and panic bars. If the protected door is opened, the unit emits an audible alarm. A key operated override will silence the alarm and allow authorised exits.

The sturdy metal unit is delivered in emergency exit green (RAL 6029) and is fitted with a profile cylinder, a 9V battery featuring a low battery warning facility and fluorescent warning stickers. ExitDoorShield can be fitted to almost any type of door and comes with full fitting instructions.

An optional RF transmitter can be fitted inside the unit to enable a signal to be forwarded either to a remote alarm unit or several doors can be monitored using an annunciation panel located elsewhere in the building.

How the ExitDoorShield Works

Closed Position

The unit is positioned directly underneath the door handle. However, the door can be opened with a single grasp

Individual Passing

Authorised personnel do not need to use the door handle. Instead they open the door by unlocking the latch without triggering the alarm



Emergency Opening

While pressing down the door handle the ExitDoorGuard automatically moves down vertically. It is possible to use the emergency exit with one grasp. A permanent alarm signal is triggered which can be switched off with a key

Permanent Passing

The unit can be pushed down without activating the alarm by using the key. The door can then be opened normally
